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combining their years of experience working with individuals on the autism spectrum the authors bring practical ideas and teaching methods for offering visual supports to students with autism spectrum disorders

this title recognizes the importance of offering stabilization strategies that afford students a better regulated body often enabling students with classic autism to increase their time in school most of them working up to full day participation

typically asd high school graduates are unprepared for the transition to independence early ongoing training in the social skills crucial to establishing successful adult relationships in college vocational school residential living or on the job can help preparing for life guides readers through the legal financial educational vocational and community resources available after graduation the essence of the book lies in the 73 skill lessons targeting nonverbal communication empathy anger anxiety

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
